

OBJECTION TO THE ALLOCATION OF THE COAL YARD SITE AS A WASTE MANAGEMENT SITE

Do you know that Brighton and Hove City Council are proposing to allocate the Coal Yard site (see map overleaf) as a waste management site?

Do you know that you have only until December 23rd to object?

Both Hove Station Neighbourhood Forum and the owners of the site are objecting to this proposal.

But the more local people object, the more likely it is that this proposal will be withdrawn.
