Creation of Energy improvement projects such as retro fitting the older housing stock with high levels of insulation, solar panels and sustainable surface water storage.





Greening the neighbourhood, including new street tree planting schemes such as a recent project in Marmion Road. See below




The sustainable treatment of rainwater is an important consideration and can assist in cultivating biodiversity if used effectively
