The station and its immediate environment badly needs major improvement. We are now systematically identifying the variety of **ideas for action** that will enable the area to become an **important centre of** the proposed **Hove Station Quarter**



Dubarry Buildings

– a local heritage landmark and Business Centre

- Should there be more flats on the roof ?
(a controversial planning application has recently been withdrawn)
- Should there be enhanced heritage protection ?
- Should the Conservation Areas be extended north of the station?
- Should the future of the Hove Business Park be protected?

Traffic calming?

Wilbury Road /Newtown Road - The Drive / Old Shoreham Road 'rat-run'
Fonthill Road - acceleration down to the bridge and up from the bridge

An accessible Hove Station

- Renovate deteriorating footbridge: lifts or replacement ?
- Additional footbridge ? (funded (in part at least) from developer contributions)
- Link the station to Conway Street?
- Short term – improve the existing steps?
- Long term – new sweeping stairs behind the Station pub?

Hove Station as a Sustainable Transport Hub

- Resolve pedestrian-vehicular conflicts and crossing issues in front of station and provide footpaths on north side of the Station Approach
- Improve provision for cyclists – equivalent to that at Brighton Station
- Provide facilities for a low carbon car club

Hove Station Conservation Area

- Hove Station Boulevard to be created by enhancing Goldstone Villas commercial area - improvement of pavements ? - additional flower boxes ?
- Station forecourt to be changed from a car wash to an amenity open space ?
- Additional floors to be added to Cliftonville Court to fund a major face-lift ?
