(b) NP Policies

1. Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) - MG reported city-wide dissatisfaction with council officers' control of CIL and lack of progress on increasing community groups involvement in discussion of priorities for the local investment of a 'neighbourhood portion' in local infrastructure improvement. There is growing pressure for increased transparency in the allocation of both Section 106 and CIL funds MG and HL will progress.

2. Traffic and Parking . NP Part 2 identifies the need for a new traffic management and parking policy for the NP area to take account of the cumulative impact of the major redevelopment projects in the Hove Station Quarter area and the development of Toads Hole. Campaigning for BHCC action will be a high priority for the Forum.

Fonthill Road residents are developing a Community Speedwatch application. Excessive traffic speed and rat running in Fonthill Road, Newtown Road and Wilbury Avenue merit the attention of a dedicated WG.

3. Trees - BHCC costs new street trees at £2000 per tree thereby depleting CIL funds. Hove Civic Society has developed a trees policy, drawing on the NP policy and has included it in its submission on City Plan 2.
